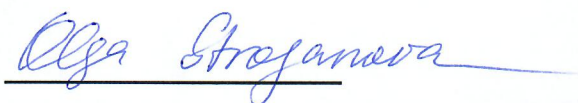

I have reviewed the annual report and accounts as well as the Board's administration for the "Film in Malmo" association for the year 2020. It is the Board that is responsible for the accounting documents and the administration. My responsibility is to express an opinion on the accounts and the other administration based on my audit.

The audit was conducted in accordance with the generally accepted auditing standards in Sweden. This means that I have planned and conducted the audit to provide me reasonable assurance that the annual report does not contain any substantial errors. An audit involves examining a selection of supporting documents for figures and other information in the accounting records. An audit also includes examining the register of members, the accounting principles and the Board's application of them and assessing the overall information in the annual report. I have examined the register of members, significant decisions, measures and circumstances in the association to determine whether any member has acted in violation of the association's statutes. I believe that my audit provides a reasonable basis for my statement below.

The annual report has been prepared in accordance with the Swedish Annual Accounts Act and thus gives a true and fair view of the association's earnings and position in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in Sweden.

The Board have, in my opinion, acted in accordance with the Association's bylaws. At the Extraordinary General Meeting in November 2020, it was permitted to distribute Malmo City's support among the board members and the conflict situation has been resolved in my opinion. Therefore, I recommend the General Meeting to grant the Board discharge for the time covered by the audit.
